Technique: In the Middle

This technique makes the greeting the focal point of your card.

## You will need the following materials for this technique:

- Large greeting stamp
- Other stamps to decorate the card
- Neutral cardstock
- Stampin' Write marker in complimentary color
- Ink
- Ruler
- Large Post-It Notes
- Step 1: Stamp the greeting in the center of the neutral cardstock.
- Step 2: Use the ruler to draw a line above and below the stamped greeting. The lines should stop 1/2" in from both edges of the cardstock. I used the brush-tip end of the marker to create a more prominent line.
- Step 3: Place the Post-It note so that it is along the upper line covering the sentiment.
- Step 4: Stamp your image.
- Step 5: Remove the Post-It, flip the card 180 degrees and place the Post-It along the second line and

stamp your image along the bottom of the card.
