



Card Recipe:

- Pacific Point cut one piece at 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", score and fold at 4-1/4"; cut one piece at 3 x 4-1/2"
- Whisper White cut one piece at 4-1/8 x 5-3/8", cut one piece at 2-7/8 x 4-3/8"
- Cherry Cobbler Baker's Twine, 3 pieces about 6" each
- Inks: Pacific Point, Cherry Cobbler, Night of Navy
- Stamp Sets: Sea Street and And Many More

Instructions:

1. Stamp the octopus in the center of the small white mat in night of navy. Stamp the fish stream diagonally above and below it in pacific point. Stamp the small crab in the lower right corner in cherry cobbler. Attach this to the small pacific point mat.
2. Wrap the 3 pieces of baker's twine around the large white mat and attach to the back with glue dots. Attach the mat to the card base and attach the layers centered over the top of the twine.
3. Stamp the sentiment in night of navy in the lower left corner.



Card Recipe:

- Whisper White cut at 4-1/4 x 11", score and fold at 5-1/2"; cut one piece at 3-1/2 x 3-3/4"; cut one piece at 3/4 x 3", one scrap for heart and flowers
- Pacific Point cut at 7/8 x 3-1/8"
- Crushed Curry cut at 3-5/8 x 3-7/8"
- Inks: Real Red, Pacific Point, old olive and Crushed Curry
- Stamp Set: Pictogram Punches
- Rhinestones
- Itty Bitty Punch Pack

Instructions:

1. Stamp the vase and stems in crushed curry and old olive on the center of the small white mat. Stamp the flowers in each of the other colors.
2. Stamp a flower in each color and punch it out. Attach to the coordinating flower on the mat with a dimensional off-setting it slightly. Add a rhinestone to the center. Layer this on the crushed curry mat and attach to the card front centered toward the top.
3. Stamp the sentiment in pacific point on the white. Create banner ends on the white and pacific point strips. Attach the white to the blue and add with dimensionals to the card front below the image mat. Add rhinestones as desired.
4. Stamp the heart in red, punch it out and attach to the blue heart sentiment with a dimensional.



Card Recipe:

- Whisper White cut at 4-1/4 x 11"
- Stampin' Write Markers: Perfect Plum, Blushing Bride, Daffodil Delight and Pear Pizzazz
- Soft Suede Ink
- Rhinestones
- Stamp Sets: A Dozen Thoughts, Pictogram Punches

Instructions:

1. Ink the vase, stems and flowers with the markers and stamp in the center of the card front. Add rhinestones to the center of each flower.
2. Stamp your sentiment in soft suede centered below the flowers.



Card Recipe:

- Pool Party cut at 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", score and fold at 4-1/4"; cut one piece at 1/2 x 3-1/2" making banner ends
- Whisper White cut at 4-1/8 x 5-3/8", cut one piece at 1 x 3" making banner ends; scrap for stars
- Inks: Blushing Bride and Pool Party
- Paper Doily
- Blushing Bride baker's twine
- Itty Bitty Punches and Itty Bitty Epoxy Sticker Embellishments
- Stamp Sets: Dotty Angles and Pictogram Punches

Instructions:

1. Create a background with dotty angles in blushing bride on the white mat. Attach to the card base. Wrap the baker's twine around twice and tie in a bow at the top.
2. Attach the doily to the center of the card over the twine.
3. Stamp the sentiment on the white strip and stamp 3 stars on the scrap white all in pool party. Punch the stars and add an epoxy star to the top of each.
4. Layer the white banner on top of the pool party and attach to the center of the doily. Attach one star with a dimensional to the star on the sentiment and attach the other two with dimensionals above the sentiments.



Card Recipe:

- Stamp Sets: Serene Silhouettes and A Dozen Thoughts
- Inks: Pear Pizzazz, Cajun Craze, Early Espresso
- Very Vanilla cut at 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", score and fold at 4-1/4", cut one piece at 2 x 4-1/4"
- Cajun Craze cut at 2-1/8 x 4-3/8"
- Early Espresso Cotton Ribbon
- Pearls
- Sponge Dauber

Instructions:

1. Ink up the image in pear pizzazz then use the sponge dauber to dot on some Cajun Craze ink around the edges of the flowers and stamp this on the small vanilla piece. Attach to the Cajun Craze piece. Tie the ribbon around the bottom and attach the entire piece to the left side of the card.
2. Stamp the sentiment in the lower right with early espresso.
3. Add pearls as desired.



Card Recipe:

- Very Vanilla cut at 4-1/4 x 11", score and fold at 5-1/2"; cut one piece at 3-1/4 x 3-3/4", scrap to cut with Word Window Punch
- Inks: Bermuda Bay, Soft Suede, Early Espresso
- Sponge Daubers
- Linen Thread
- Sea Street and And Many More stamp sets
- Soft Suede cut at 4-1/8 x 5-3/8" and one piece cut at 3-3/8 x 3-7/8"
- Crumb Cake cut at 4 x 5-1/4" and run through the big shot with the wood grain folder

Instructions:

1. Sponge the wood grain embossed crumb cake piece with soft suede ink using a dauber. Attach this to the soft suede mat and add these to the card base.
2. Stamp the fish diagonally on the vanilla mat with soft suede. Stamp the star fish with soft suede and the anchor in early espresso as shown in the photo. Use your daubers to sponge on soft suede in and Bermuda bay to give it the look of ocean and sand. Start from the outside edges and work in toward the center and get lighter as you go.
3. Layer this on to the soft suede mat. Wrap linen thread around 3 times and tie in a bow toward the top of the piece. Attach this with dimensionals toward the top center of the card front.
4. Stamp the sentiment in soft suede on vanilla and punch with the word window punch. Attach to the card front as desired.



Card Recipe:

- Mossy Meadow cut at 4-1/4 x 11", score and fold at 5-1/2"
- Tangelo Twist cut at 4 x 5-1/4"
- Crushed Curry cut at 1-1/2 x 3", one piece punched with the 1-1/2" scallop circle punch
- Very Vanilla cut at 1-1/4 x 3" and one piece punched with the 1-1/2" scallop circle punch
- Serene Silhouettes and Fabulous 4 stamp sets
- Wood Grain embossing folder and big shot
- Linen thread
- Inks: Tangelo Twist and Mossy Meadow

Instructions:

1. Stamp the tree image in tangelo twist on the tangelo twist mat and then run it through the big shot in the wood grain embossing folder. Attach it to the card base.
2. Stamp the sentiment in tangelo twist on the vanilla and layer on the crushed curry strip. Attach to the card front by lining it up with the right edge of the card and making it about 1-1/4" above the card bottom.
3. Attach some linen thread loops to the left of the sentiment. Stamp the flower/butterfly image in mossy meadow on the vanilla and punch with the scallop circle. Layer this off set on top of the crushed curry scalloped circle. Attach to the card front with dimensionals over the linen thread.
