

Interactive Sliding Card

Supplies:

- Paper trimmer or craft knife and ruler
- 7 Kids Craft Store Foraging Faeries stamp set
- Catherine Pooler Midnight Black Ink
- · Copic Markers
- Misti or stamp positioner
- Scor-Buddy and Bone Folder
- · Scissors to fussy cut images or Brother Scan-n-Cut
- One die cut circle or shape of your choice and frame (3") using a punch or die cut and die cutting machine
- 1" circle punch or circle die and cutting machine
- Double sided adhesive, foam tape
- Patterned Paper cut at 4-1/4 x 5-1/2"
- White Cardstock cut at $4-1/4 \times 5-1/2$ ", one piece cut at $2-3/4 \times 4-3/4$ " for your tab panel


Instructions:

- 1. Cut all papers to size.
- 2. Stamp and cut out faery images and sentiments.
- 3. Cut your patterned paper panel by making two cuts 4'' long 3/4'' from each long side of the paper and 34'' from the top of the paper panel.
- 4. Cut horizontally between the two vertical cuts along the short side of the paper 34" from the bottom edge.
- 5. Punch or die cut a semi-circle out of the top of both panels opposite the cut end of the flap.

- 6. Score your flap from the uncut end of the flap at $\frac{34}{7}$, $\frac{2-1}{4}$, $\frac{4}{7}$ and create a mountain fold so the center score line pops up away from the card base.
- 7. Attach your tab panel to the back side of the patterned paper along the cut end of the flap from the 4" score line to the bottom of the flap.
- 8. Attach the patterned paper to the white panel with the tab in between so that it shows between the semi-circular tab holes. The tab should pull freely opening and closing the panel.
- 9. Attach your circle and frame to the patterned paper so that the adhesive is on the front of the pop-up folded piece. Add your stamped and colored images and sentiment.
- 10. Stamp a sentiment on the white panel so that it shows when the tab is pulled and the front folds up.
