

Tips for Creating Snowfall Effect

- Ink a splatter stamp in Versa
 Mark ink and stamp to cover your background. Add white embossing powder and heat set. Ink blend the sky.
- Ink a snowfall stencil in Versa
 Mark ink and use white embossing powder. Ink a blue sky.
- Stamp a small snowflake stamp over your background in white craft ink or Versa Mark with white embossing powder.
- Use a snow embossing folder on dark paper and brush the embossed bits with white craft ink on a dauber.

Creating Snowbanks

- Using a wave or hill stencil or a hill mask you cut from masking paper, place the mask/stencil where you want your first snowbank.
- With a blending brush, ink blend in light violet, blue, pink, or gray lightly along the edge of your hill mask.
- 3. Repeat to create as many snowbanks as you want Varying the size and shape of the snowbanks so they look natural by using different parts of the mask or stencil.

Creating Falling Snow

- 1. Create your snowbanks.
- 2. Stamp your scene images.
- Stamp your snowfall stamp or splatter stamp in VersaMark ink to cover the sky background and do a few in front of the stamped images.
- 4. Add your white embossing powder and heat set.
- Using a blending brush, ink blend your sky over the snowfall.
- Add sentiments and embellishments to your finished layout.
