

Jacob's Coat

- Ink blend a colorful background and dry the ink with your heat tool.
- 2. Use your embossing buddy.
- Stamp your image using Versa Mark watermark ink.
- Use Clear embossing powder over your image.
- 5. Heat your powdered image.
- Ink blend in black or a dark color of your choosing over the entire piece.
- 7. Use a cloth to buff the embossed images.

Faux Enamel

- Die cut or fussy cut the word die or shape you want to enamel.
- 2. Completely cover the piece with Versa Mark ink.
- Pour clear embossing powder over this and heat set.
- 4. Repeat steps 2 and 3, at least 2 more times.

Faux Metal

- Die cut or fussy cut the piece you want to look like metal.
- 2. Completely cover the piece in Versa Mark ink.
- Cover with your favorite metallic embossing powder and heat set.
- 4. Repeat step 2 and 3 if you want it thicker or smoother.

Dipped Enamel Effect

- Die cut your piece in a color card stock.
- Cover the top portion of the die in Versa Mark ink, add clear embossing powder and heat set.
- 3. Ink the bottom portion of your die in Versa Mark ink. Cover with white embossing powder and heat set.
