



### Sponge Dauber Background Dots

1. Ink up sponge dauber on your ink pad.
2. Place dauber against paper and twist as you push down.
3. Add dots where you want them and move on to the second color.
4. Use a new dauber for each color.
5. Label daubers with a paint pen or label maker.

### Ink Blending

1. Ink up your blending tool on your ink pad.
2. Wipe off excess ink on your scrap paper or craft mat.
3. Starting at the edge of your paper, brush your ink onto your paper in a circular motion.
4. Repeat until you are happy with the blend.
5. Add different colors where you want them.

### Spritzing With Water

1. Once you have created your ink blended background, spritz it once or twice with water.
2. Allow the water to react with the ink to remove the ink where the water landed.
3. When you want the reaction to stop, blot up the water with a towel.

### Ombre Ink Blending

1. Start at one end of the paper and blend your ink so that it is very dark on the starting end.
2. Blend down the paper lightly as the ink is being used up to create a gradual lightening of the color.
3. Repeat the process always starting at the dark end and lightening as you move to the opposite end leaving some of the paper white at the end.
