



### Jacob's Coat

1. Ink blend a colorful background and dry the ink with your heat tool.
2. Use your embossing buddy.
3. Stamp your image using Versa Mark watermark ink.
4. Use Clear embossing powder over your image.
5. Heat your powdered image.
6. Ink blend in black or a dark color of your choosing over the entire piece.
7. Use a cloth to buff the embossed images.

### Faux Enamel

1. Die cut or fussy cut the word die or shape you want to enamel.
2. Completely cover the piece with Versa Mark ink.
3. Pour clear embossing powder over this and heat set.
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3, at least 2 more times.

### Faux Metal

1. Die cut or fussy cut the piece you want to look like metal.
2. Completely cover the piece in Versa Mark ink.
3. Cover with your favorite metallic embossing powder and heat set.
4. Repeat step 2 and 3 if you want it thicker or smoother.

### Dipped Enamel Effect

1. Die cut your piece in a color card stock.
2. Cover the top portion of the die in Versa Mark ink, add clear embossing powder and heat set.
3. Ink the bottom portion of your die in Versa Mark ink. Cover with white embossing powder and heat set.
