

Color Coordination

Color selection is the key to making beautiful cards. Stampin' Up! has 41 Core Colors plus 10 rotating In-Colors to give you a nice variety of color options. They have them classified into 4 color families: Regals, Subtles, Brights, and Neutrals. You also have two sets of 5 In-Colors that hang around for 2 years and then get retired for a new set of In-Colors to keep your choices fresh.

A helpful tool for selecting color combinations that work together is the Color Coach Cards.



How To Make Your Own Color Coach

- Download and print the charts on Basic White card stock or white copy paper.
- Download here: <https://tinyurl.com/ycyjjxe9>
- Cut the cards apart along the dotted lines or cut the cards down to 2 3/4" x 3 3/4".
- For added stability, layer each card onto its 3" x 4" colored cardstock. For example, the Cherry Cobbler card should be adhered to Cherry Cobbler card stock. (A sample package of each color family and In-Color set makes this a more affordable task!)
